Film Music: An Historical Survey

Course Description: Music in film, both specially composed and/or appropriated, often determines the character and emotional gravity of the greatest films. Some films, such as *Taxi Driver*, *Vertigo*, and *2001:* A *Space Odyssey* are literally unthinkable without their scores. This seminar presents a roughly chronological survey of the greatest film scores, from masterpieces by Korngold and Hermann up to the present day. Relevant clips are presented with commentary and analysis. Also included is a discussion of the film composer's craft, with the necessity of split second timing and utter versatility.

The purpose of the course is to examine how music works within a film, not to evaluate the intrinsic quality of the film or its composer or music supervisor.
